



Sungchang Educational Institution was established on December 24, 1959 under the belief of the late Dr. Tae-Sung CHUNG, who wanted to contribute to the nation's development by fostering talent. The Foundation changed its name to Sungji from Sungchang in November 1981 and opened Busan University of Foreign Studies with 10 departments, under the founding philosophy of "The fear of the LORD is the beginning of knowledge." Since the first admission to BUFS in March 1982, BUFS was upgraded a full-scale university in 1991, positioning itself as a representative university of Busan region.



BUFS' SPECIALIZED ABROAD PROGRAMS BUFS runs specialized practice-centered programs, in which students develop themselves as global leaders with humanities and business skills. Its programs range from practical activities led by students to the curriculums that cultivate future leaders equipped with knowledge of humanities.



GLOBAL EXPERIENCE PROGRAM

BUFS Planet Program

This is a task-based program home and abroad, in which students carry out intensified major-related assignments of the courses such as Capstone Design and PBL. Based on the knowledge acquired during the semester, one selected team gets to travel abroad with their professors to complete their assignments.

NADAUM Program

Based on the knowledge acquired during the micro-major lectures, participants in this program will have an opportunity to do self-directed learning and collaborate to develop and carry out overseas projects so as to find and solve the problems in the international community,

Glocal Marketer Program

This is a task-based program, in which students have an opportunity to meet actual overseas buyers and promote and sell products of contractors. Students apply the knowledge and information they have learned, learning practical business skills and being culturally exposed.

BUFS International Cooperation Division

Students take the initiative to plan and provide volunteer services around the world. Before COVID-19, students volunteered in various countries, including Vietnam, Cambodia, Kyrgyzstan, and Mexico in the second half of 2019. With the end of the COVID-19 pandemic, the International Cooperation Division is working on more diverse service programs.

BUFS Challenge Program | Global Volunteering |

Students in this program will have a chance to do voluntary works such as building houses in the Philippines and teaching local residents Korean language, Korean martial art-Taekwondo, and painting. Since its introduction in 2007, this program has been carried out in Cambodia and the Philippines, attracting a lot of students' attention.

GLOBAL EXCHANGE PROGRAM

2+2 Dual Degree Program

In accordance with the agreements entered between BUFS and partner universities, students, who attend two universities at home and abroad for 2 years each and complete mandatory courses, will earn 2 degrees.

3+1,7+1 Study Abroad Program

In this program, credits earned in an overseas partner university for 1 year or 1 semester will be transferred to the BUFS credit system. Students are allowed to enhance their global mindset through this system.

Semester Abroad Program | SAP |

Under this short-term language program, students take language training courses at sister universities in English-speaking countries, such as the U.S., Canada, Australia, Malaysia, the Philippines, etc., during a semester ($12 \sim 16$ weeks) or vacation (4 weeks). They are expected to immerse themselves in English and are exposed to foreign cultures as well.






